Form New Habits

God's Word teaches us that when we receive Christ as our Savior and Lord, He gives us a new nature. He gives us His nature. He also gives us a spirit of discipline and self-control, which is vital in allowing us to choose the ways of our new nature. He gives us a sound mind and that means we can think about things properly without being controlled by emotion. The way we once were passes away, and we have all the equipment we need for a brand new way of behaving. God gives us the ability and offers to help us, but we are not puppets and God will not manipulate us. We must choose spirit over flesh and right over wrong. Our renewed spirits will then control our souls and bodies or, to say it another way, the inner person will control the outer person.

Without God's help we have difficulty doing things in moderation. We

frequently eat too much spend too much money, have too much entertainment, and talk too much. We are excessive in our actions because we behave emotionally.
